Dear Parishioners,

What follows is a reflection on marriage from the Diocese of Trenton.

### The Beauty of Catholic Marriage

“Catholic Marriage is unique among other marital relationships because it is a sacrament that makes Christ present in our world. The relationship between husband and wife mirrors the relationship of Jesus Christ for his people.

“In the Catholic tradition, husband and wife accept a role in God’s plan for humanity. They are ambassadors of God’s love, and they collaborate with God to keep humanity alive. The vows exchanged by the couple are a sacred pact through which the spouses embrace each other, and together embrace Jesus as their partner. Through their union with Christ they participate in the unbreakable pact between God and humanity: the covenant that was sealed in the death and resurrection of Christ.”

### Today’s Gospel Reflection

“As we listen to this Gospel, the Beatitudes jar our sensibilities. Those who are poor, hungry, weeping, or persecuted are called blessed. This is, indeed, a Gospel of reversals. Those often thought to have been forgotten by God are called blessed. In the list of “woes,” those whom we might ordinarily describe as blessed by God are warned about their peril. Riches, possessions, laughter, reputation . . . these are not things that we can depend upon as sources of eternal happiness. They not only fail to deliver on their promise; our misplaced trust in them will lead to our demise. ### Parish Community Tithing Replaces ACSA

In July 2021, the Annual Catholic Services Appeal was replaced by the Parish Community Tithe to fund the Diocesan mission and ministries.

Parishes will be asked to contribute 10% of parish general support, excluding revenue from Cemeteries, Schools, or Bishop Approved Capital Campaigns. These gifts will ensure the ministries of the Diocese, in support of the universal church, will continue to share in the goodness and growth of discipleship and stewardship throughout the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois.

Here are the highlights of this significant change:

- 1) The Annual Catholic Services Appeal (ACSA) no longer exists
- 2) Parishes will support the Diocese of Springfield mission and ministry offices through a monthly tithe (10%) from parish support.
- 3) An individual may choose to continue supporting the Bishop’s Gift Society or a particular diocesan ministry office, however these donations are not credited back to the parish in any manner.
- 4) The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, Diocesan, and Parish Second Collections will remain in place through June 30, 2022.

Due to this change, we recommend all parishioners add your previous ACSA donation amount to your general parish offering so we can make our monthly tithe. Our parish is grateful for your good stewardship during the challenges of this past year, and we hope to continue growing deeper in our relationship with Christ through discipleship and stewardship. We are all in this together, and together we will set a course for a renewed and revitalized church.
