“Who is my neighbor?”

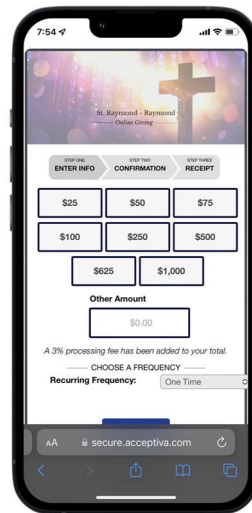
This is the seemingly embarrassing question the scribe asks Jesus. Jesus responds by helping the scholar of the law understand that the Word of God is love and it is an invitation to love, furthermore it summarizes Jesus' mission on earth. Jesus teaches and shows through words and actions that God's love is unconditional. This also means that true love of God necessarily leads his disciples to love of neighbor. Several times in his teachings, Jesus had proclaimed: “*It is mercy I desire and not sacrifices*”. Here, Jesus purposely features a priest and a Levite, for they could not officiate in the Temple if they had touched blood. Jesus wants to tell us by this that God attaches more importance to our practice of Charity and Service to others in daily life than to our practice of Worship and Prayer in his Temple, in the church. We do not serve God in the church if we do not serve Him in the family, at work, in leisure, on the street and the road... God is not hungry in the Tabernacle, but He is hungry and thirst in his poor... and hungers and thirsts are not only physical... Jesus considers as done to Himself what we do to the least among his brothers and sisters in humanity; to the destitute and the poor, those we find approachable and those we do not. That is the neighbor!

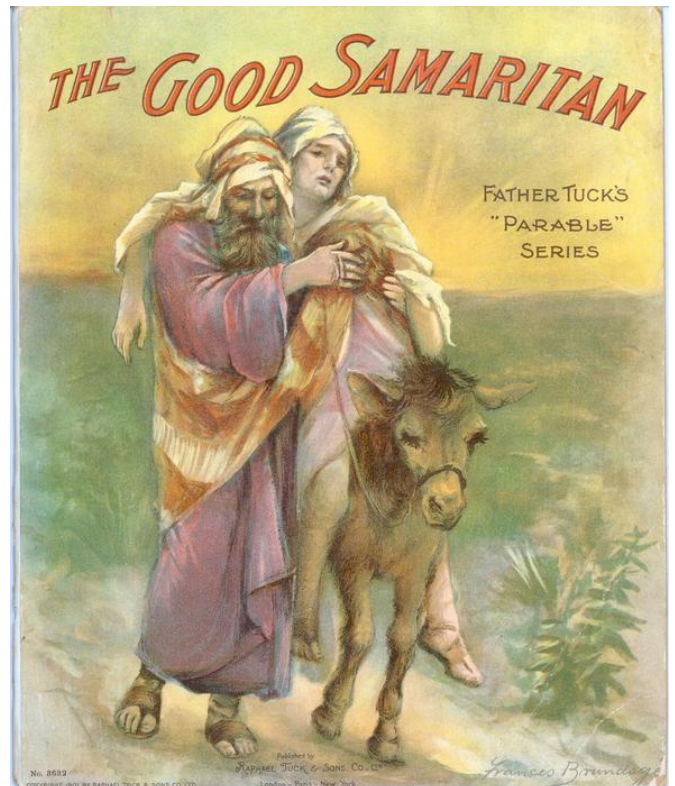

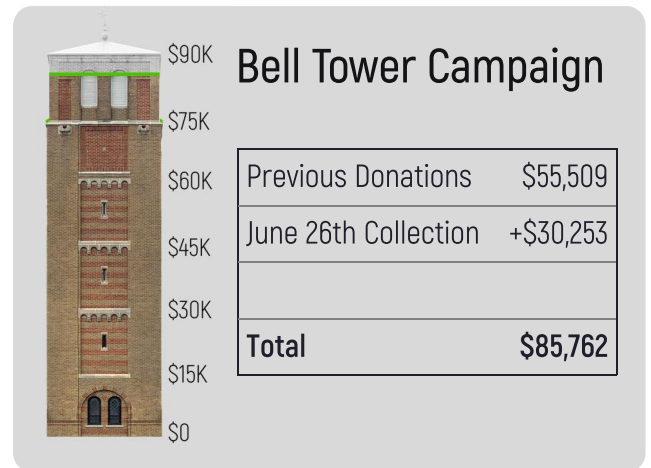
