In these our times, we live by clock. Indeed, 'time is money' as we say. We calculate time minute by minute because there are so many things to do; too many demands to fulfill, and as a result, we are overworked and have too little sleep.

We not only calculate time spent on everyday tasks but we often calculate even the time spent as disciples of Jesus-Christ as well.

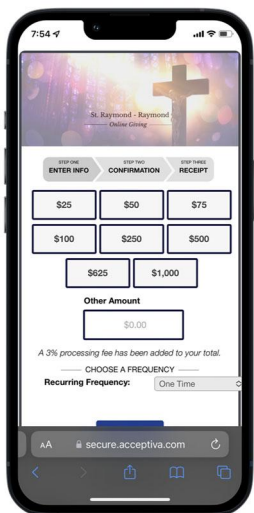
