The Gospel of this Sunday tells us that our prayers take on the strength of our faith.

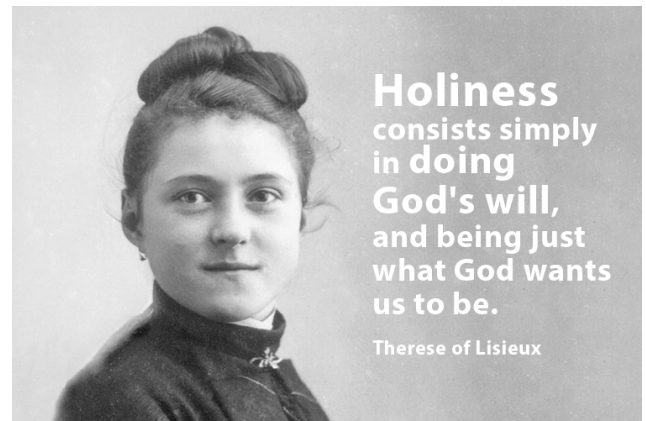

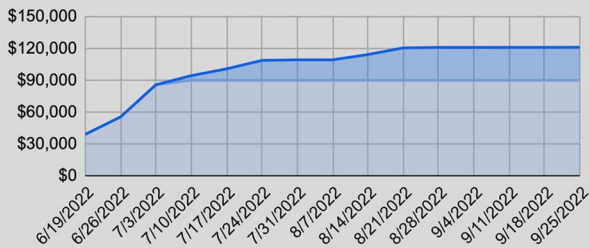
