## Father's Corner

---

### Humbled or exalted?

In some ways, we are all tempted to be like the Pharisee in the Gospel story of this Sunday. For example, we might look down on those we consider less successful, those we consider less intelligent, those we consider different from us in any way.

In some ways, we are also like the Tax collector. For example, we are aware of our needs and weaknesses, we acknowledge our faults, we apologize whenever we hurt others. The Lord invites us this week to consider the truth of who we are before God and others.

Although apparently a pious person, Jesus points the fact that this Pharisee's practices of fasting and tithing – a bit like our daily rosaries, mass attendances, – did not bring him any closer to God or to others. Simply doing religious practices in a mechanical way is not enough. Despite the fact that these practices are good in themselves, they must be accompanied by a heart turned to God and of course to others in humility, in order to bear their expected fruits.

A famous author once wrote that, “A proud person is always looking down on things and people; and, of course, as long as you're looking down, you cannot see something that is above you.” When our lives are focused on ourselves or when our attitudes and behaviors separate us from others, we cannot be lifted up by God or by others beyond where we are. Rather than focusing on ourselves, we must look beyond ourselves to God and others. That kind of humility leads to divine gifts and spiritual growth and exaltation.

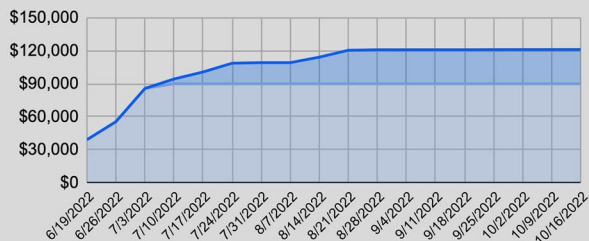
