Father's Corner

He has come to seek and save what was lost.

Zacchaeus is not that different from us in terms of how far we might go to encounter a celebrity of the moment. For example, people press to the front of a crowd to see a famous person passing by; and long lines form at theater's doors or sport stadiums to get autographs of Hollywood or football stars. But Zacchaeus was different from the people in these examples because of who he was; because of whom he wanted to see and because of what happened to him next.

This despised tax collector (another one, after the one we heard about last Sunday) went that far, (or that up) to see Jesus. And fortunately Jesus did more than fulfill his curiosity, he went to the extent of staying at his house and, led him to a complete conversion.

The same Jesus continues his mission of transforming the world even these days among us.

Everyday, he continues to seek and to save us by coming to our house, to our hearts in the Holy Eucharist and moving us beyond where we are. We respond to his presence through the everyday opportunities that present themselves, for example, when we seek reconciliation with a loved one we have unfortunately hurt; when we reach out to that stranger or that outcast among us; or when we overcome our fears and dare to speak out in the face of injustice.

If we do so, then our joy, like that of Zacchaeus, will arise from receiving Jesus and letting ourselves be sought after and saved by him.
