---

### He is not God of the dead, but of the living.

None of us likes to be ridiculed. For example, we don't like our profession, our race, our country or our religion to be despised by others, even through a joke. The Sadducees in the Gospel of this Sunday ridicule Jesus and everyone who believes in life after death. But rather than destroying them with a harsh reply, Jesus seizes this opportunity to teach them about what is the core of his mission: to bring true life to a dying humanity because of sin.

Jesus lived and served as one who was fully attuned to God; "God of the living!" That's why all his encounters with sinners were life-giving. His promise of new life and our own hope of sharing in Eternal life are based on the very way he lived, because he was able to see life even where all other religious leaders thought there were only death.

Jesus reached out to those whom others considered "dead" such as the lepers, sinners, prostitutes, outcasts... His relationship with the "God of the living, not of the dead" enabled him to bring even these people in touch with new life.

Like Jesus, we also must spend our lives deepening our relationship with the same God of life and sharing that life with others. We can do so through concrete choices and actions directed to their good. In doing this, we will attest to God's life acting through us; and reaffirm that he is indeed God of life, God of the living.

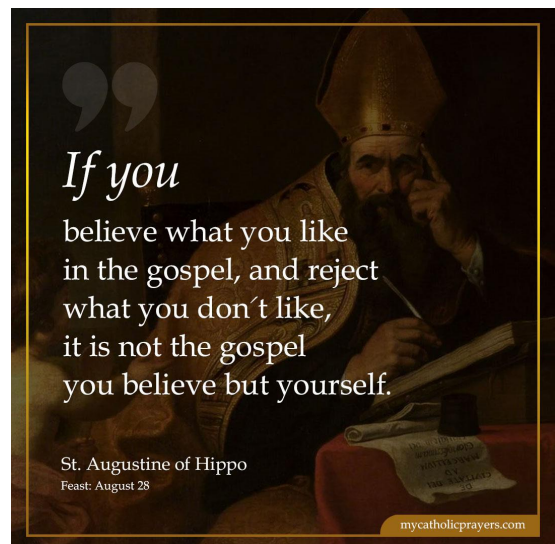
### Marriage and Family

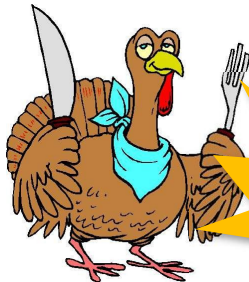
