

Father's Corner

If only...

How often don't we say, If only... If only I had gone to the doctor sooner; If only I had not made that harsh remark; If only I had not taken that last drink. The "if only" points to a wish that another decision or action had been taken. Both Martha and Mary express this same sentiment to Jesus. "If only" Jesus had come sooner, Lazarus would still be alive.

When facing death, there are always things left unsaid, undone; there are always things left undone. It is natural to want to go back. "If only..." But Jesus, "the resurrection and the life," invites us to go forward. Death is not the end. For Lazarus. For him. For us. If only ...we come to deeper believing.

Death leaves us shaken, uneasy, grieving. In our human reckoning, it is the ultimate mystery. With his disclosure of himself as "the resurrection and the life," Jesus reveals death to be merely the penultimate mystery. Death is necessary, but not the end. The real ending, the final mystery, is something entirely new: fullness of Life in eternal union with God. If only...

Do I have to pray out loud at Mass?

It is very important to pray out loud as an expression of our heart-felt participation in the Mass. We pray out loud to remain focused on the Mass, so that our mind, heart, and body (with lips praying and responding out loud) are all united in integral participation.

Catholics understand that togetherness is very important when we celebrate the Mass. The Mass is a communal gathering of worship and not just some individuals praying in the same place. The Mystical Body of Christ is the one family of the faithful gathered together in Christ. With this thinking, it is important to pray out loud as a family, all participating together in unison in our worship during Mass. We are the united community of the Body of Christ in the service of prayer and the sacrifice of love in the Mass.
