"And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim."

As we come to the end of the Easter season, the Church invites us to reflect on the incredible journey undertaken by Jesus out of love for us.

Eight weeks ago, we entered the church waving palm branches to mark Jesus's entry into Jerusalem. During that holiest of weeks, we remembered how Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, shared bread and wine with his disciples. Then, after an agonizing evening in the garden, Jesus took up his cross. Not long after, nails pierce his skin as he hangs and cries out and soon, breathed his last. The story should have ended here with death: but we know that is not what happened...

Throughout the last fifty days of Easter, we soaked in stories of the resurrected Lord who still had some teaching and revealing to do to his disciples. Jesus was not ready to leave quite yet.

Now, on this solemnity of Pentecost, Jesus turns the work over to his disciples of all generations, to us. Jesus's journey continues, though now we are the ones to take on the preaching and praying, the forgiving and healing that he did.

Guided by the Holy Spirit, we, the disciples of today, are called to carry on Christ's saving work. How do we take on such a major mission? We do so by coming together like our ancestors did for that first Pentecost celebration; a diverse group of people bonded by their amazement at the mighty acts of God. We do so by remembering that we are part of one body with many parts, each part called to use its gifts for the betterment of the whole.

What is the Prayer of the Faithful or Universal prayers?

In the Prayer of the Faithful comes right after the Creed. The assembly stands to pray, in a common priesthood shared by all the baptized, for the concerns of the Church and the salvation of the whole world (thus called 'universal prayers').

Intercessory prayer is a very powerful and beneficial way to intercede for all humanity. As we lift up to God those in need, including ourselves, He hears and responds for the good of those for whom we pray. He is our Heavenly Father Who takes care of His children.

Jesus says: "Ask and you shall receive," and "Where two or more are gathered in My Name and in prayer, I am there with you." Together, as the local Church, we gather in prayer united with the universal Church in Christ. We pray for the needs of the Church, the world, civil authorities, those in need, and the local community, including those who are sick and have recently passed away, and for the salvation of the world.
