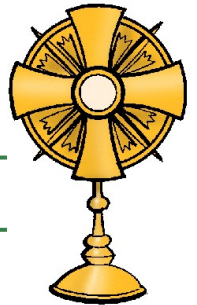
Father's Corner

“Ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.”

In the 1st reading of this Sunday, God says to his people, “I bore you on eagles' wings!” This image gives us a feeling of protection and security. God wants to keep us from crashing in this life, but he does not want to provide free airplane rides so we can get through this life without personal work or effort. Rather he wants us to mature, to grow up, using the gifts, talents and energy he put in us. We will not get to the Promised Land of heaven without effort on our part.

But even in our struggles on the journey, he still reveals himself as the good shepherd, always ready to come to our rescue. That's why Jesus, in the gospel is moved as he looks at those seeking him. To him they are like sheep without a shepherd, lost and abandoned. He wants to reach out and help all of them but he knows he cannot. So he chooses people to help him. He gives them the name “apostles”, which means those who are sent out.

What are the two cloth pieces placed on the altar for?

The altar servers prepare the altar by placing the corporal and purificator on the altar.

The corporal is a square piece of white linen used as an undercover for the sacred vessels used in the consecration, so as to collect any particles or drops of the consecrated Host or wine that may fall onto the altar.

The purificator is used to dry the sacred vessels at the end of Communion when they are purified. These cloth pieces are usually washed in a special way in the sacarium due to their use as sacred clothes with the Eucharistic species.

What is the sacarium and what is it used for?

The sacarium (sometimes called a “piscina”) is a special sink found in the sacristy of some churches, usually with a lid marked by a cross. It was developed for the proper disposal of sacred elements. It has a drain that goes directly into the ground. In this way the natural elements of bread and wine are returned to the earth in a more dignified manner than if they were drained into a holding tank or sewer where they would be mingled with sewage. A more common use of the sacarium is to dispose of water that was used to wash the various liturgical linens.
