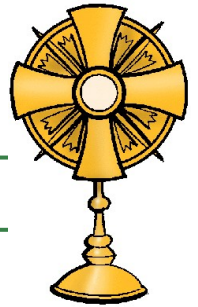
Father's Corner

“Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul.”

We usually run very fast from what we fear. We face and stand with what brings us great joy. The Gospel of this Sunday tells us what to fear: whatever destroys body and soul! It also tells us why we rejoice: we are chosen to speak fearlessly "in the light" and acknowledge who Jesus is.

Jesus tells us we do not need to fear those who have power only over our bodies. What we rather ought to fear, he says, is "the one who can destroy both soul and body." This one is our own very selves when we deny Jesus, for to deny him is to bring about our own eternal death.

When and how do we deny Jesus? We do so when we are afraid to speak out in face of injustice in the workplace. When we are afraid to stay in quiet time in prayer to come to better know Jesus and ourselves more deeply. When we are afraid to associate with those who are different from us. This fear paralyzes. This fear kills. Life comes from giving ourselves over to Jesus who alone has power to strengthen us and remove our fears and help us to act boldly as he did. In Jesus we can face everything and rejoice.

What else is placed on the altar for the Consecration?

The chalice, which will hold the wine and water for consecration, is usually placed on the altar as well, along with the paten (a plate, typically made of gold or silver) holding the main Host to be consecrated.

The Sacramentary (or Missal) is also placed on the altar so the priest can pray the prayers of the Mass. Once the gifts are brought up and accepted by the priest, he gives them to the altar servers to bring to the altar.

Sometimes (usually on solemnities and feasts), the deacon and priest will use incense to incense the gifts and the altar, and then the deacon or other minister will incense the priest and people.
