

Father's Corner

Jesus said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

When we are first introduced to people, we learn their name, what they do, where they live. But this first encounter rarely gives us more than mere casual information. Only following encounters, conversations and shared experiences can reveal the depth of a person. Time reveals all.

So we must take time to encounter Jesus-Christ and come to know who he is for us and what knowing him demands of us.

Jesus asks the disciples twice about his identity, because the disciples' first answer expressed the people's common expectation of who the Messiah would be. By Jesus' pushing them a bit further, Peter professes what he has come to know personally: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." And yet it is Peter who will later deny knowing who Jesus is. Getting to know Jesus well enough to profess him with consistent conviction requires a lifelong process of encountering Jesus and being continually transformed by him.

What will professing who Jesus is demand of us? How will it change us? Where will it take us? Knowing who Jesus is demands of us self-giving, steadfastness in face of persecution, embracing what it means to be a community of believers; the church. Knowing who Jesus is changes us into being more like his loving, compassionate, forgiving, healing, merciful Self. Knowing who Jesus is takes us to the cross in this life and ultimately takes us to everlasting Life where we will be one with him in glory.

Immediately after the Consecration, the Memorial Acclamation or "The mystery of faith" is recited, which may be one of four prayers, such as: "Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again" to proclaim our belief in the miracle that has just occurred on the altar.


