FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area. He said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

Constructing a new building is always challenging. So many elements need to be taken into consideration. Design details, funding concerns, building permits and codes, inspections are all time consuming and distressful. However, building up the community of the Church as the living temple of God's Presence is even more challenging. Because much more is at stake.

In the Gospel of this third Sunday of Lent, Jesus visits the Temple and here, he overturns more than money tables. He actually overturns the Jewish understanding of the Temple, from a building "under construction" to his own body. He overturns our understanding of death from the end of life to the beginning of new, risen Life. He overturns our very selves from an empty lot of unbelief to a beautiful structure of believers. We are God's new construction and God overturns all our challenges in order to build us into living signs of divine Presence and saving works.

By overturning those aspects of our human nature inclined to pride, self-centeredness, anger, envy, jealousy, greed, God builds us into living signs of his divine Presence and saving work. We become the new temple, the Body of Christ, open to humility, compassion, forgiveness, healing, service, love. What is at stake is bringing to beautiful completion the construction of God's new temple; the Church. What kind of living stone are we in this new Temple?


