FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house."

Why do we accept something being said from one person, but not accept the same thing from another? Some people say things to us that we hear and easily accept, others say things to us that we take it with a grain of salt.

The credibility of persons rests to a large extent on the relationship we have with them, the reputation or credentials that precede them, their social status, or their actions which speak louder than their words. Yet our growing in knowledge of and appreciation for others depends on a level of receptivity much deeper than simply hearing and accepting.

The townspeople in the Gospel of this Sunday had every reason to believe what Jesus was saying: they knew him well, he had a well-seated reputation for teaching and healing, and his actions had already revealed his power. But they did not receive him. Why?

The answer comes from Jesus himself: they lacked faith that leads to letting go of preconceived expectations to receive the Person who could bring them new gifts and life.

The Gospel of this fourteenth Sunday invites us to reflect on how open we are and to whom. And to realize that Jesus is present to us now with his gifts of wisdom and healing through those whom we might least suspect; those nearest to us. Here is our leap of faith: that others can be the presence and power of God for us, bringing us untold gifts. So, how open we are and to whom?
