FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits.

People today are perceived to have "authority" because they have power, wealth, weapons, position or fame. Most of the times this authority is self-serving and coercing, it does not always bring forth greater life in people nor is it always focused on the well-being of others.

However we also know other people who are greatly admired because they use their authority and power for the good of others. Jesus' exercise of authority grew up with his love and concern for the people and carried forth his mission to call people to new life and growth.

It is this same mission to which he calls us again this Sunday, and for which he gives us authority.

The Christian perception of mission and authority is very different from that of our popular culture nowadays. When we see and respond to the needs of others, we are carrying forth Jesus' mission and we are acting on the authority he is giving us.

Being sent by Jesus with authority to continue his mission is as simple as doing our everyday tasks with his love, care, and purpose.
