FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus replied,

"If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off.

It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire."

We often make difficult choices to gain what we want. For example, we choose what and how we eat in order to have a polished body; we choose to cut back on expenses in order to have money for a new car; we choose certain relationships in order to find support and understanding as well as challenge when we need it.

The Gospel of this Sunday calls us to make even more radical choices that go beyond our immediate desires. Jesus calls us to choose life, even when this involves something extremely radical: cut off whatever behaviors lead ourselves or others away from him and truly acting in his name.

Choosing discipleship means aligning our way of thinking and acting to be that of Jesus. Discipleship must shape our daily choices, both in terms of what we cut back (destructive behaviors) and what we expand (our understanding of where and in whom we see the Spirit working). Choose life!

Membership is by action, not by certificate. Simply having a baptismal certificate doesn't mean we belong in the deepest sense of what "belonging" truly means. Belonging to the community of the Church means taking on the vision and goals of Jesus and working diligently to implement them in our daily life. This is true discipleship, and it is challenging.
