# FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus told them, "from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh."

When we look around, we see how surrounded we are by seriously ruptured relationships: many family members are not talking to each other for years, divorce occurring frequently, long time friendships falling apart because of a single hurtful word or incident.

Fortunately, we also are surrounded by healthy and enduring relationships: some adult children becoming best friends with their parents, some aging couples approaching their golden wedding anniversary, some friends reconciling after years of separation.

In order to grow and endure, relationships require hard work, openness to growth, forgiveness, love, and grace. "From the beginning of creation" as Jesus reminds us, all was created good. Our openness of heart to each other makes visible that divinely created good by which God embraces and blesses us.

Enduring relationships are not dependent upon any human laws or conditions, but they are a gift of God whose grace helps us embrace the goodness of the other. By receiving, embracing, and blessing the children, Jesus showed us what is needed for relationships to endure. Having healthy, loving relationships does not imply that there are no struggles. Very often difficulties strengthen a relationship by softening our hearts, bringing us to better communication, more openness to the other, and greater willingness to forgive both the other and ourselves. In such openness of heart God is present, and the kingdom of God is among us.
