# FATHER'S COLUMN

While Jesus was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah.

In the Gospel of this 2nd Sunday of Lent, Jesus reveals to the disciples that he is the Son of God. This revelation is extraordinary, but the event is not one of passivity. We, too, are invited into a life of transformation as we strive to become the people we are called to be.

Part of our own transformation, just like that of the disciples, is our awareness and alertness of the presence of God. St. Luke writes, "Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him."

What keeps our own minds from being fully awake? Do our own experiences, prejudices and biases keep us from fully encountering God? Do we have difficulty recognizing the belovedness of others? Are we simply going through the motions of prayer because we are exhausted? This Second Sunday of Lent is a great opportunity to reflect on our own self-awareness.

Today we pray that we may embody the words of Paul in the 2nd reading from his letter to the Philippians: "He will change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body by the power that enables him also to bring all things into subjection to himself."

May we allow God to transform us in God's image so that our light may shine in radiant glory.
